4:32 Meeting introductions

4:36 Ms. Bramley announced citizen communications and read the guidelines for the communications; Suzie Kabat had a comment; "on behalf of myself and other concerned community members at Winn ...". Document will be shared with all CAC members through a link in the chat where members may post questions and/or comments.. Citizen Communication ended at 4:44.

4:44 Ms. Bramley introduced the budget; Ms. Blessum spoke on the budget and reviewed the allocations for the 2022-2023 school year; Funding from the city has covered the remaining .5 for our PSS and office clerk. Our Title 1 money has been reduced due to the number of free and reduced students enrolled at Winn; Ms. Johnson asked for the non-staff budget allocation clarification (materials, copier rental, custodial supplies). Ms. Johnson had several questions regarding the cost of the copy machines. She asked about the cost of renting the copier versus buying a copier outright.; In the chat: do we have a full time AP in the budget? Ms. Blessum: in the past, we used Title 1 money to cover the .5 of the AP. Ms Bramley moved to the next item on the agenda.

4:54 Ms. Bramley shared information regarding our "Early Learning Day".; There were tours throughout the day. 22 new Wildcats were enrolled. Ms. Maria, Ms. Bramley, Ms. Sandra, Ms. Blessum and Ms. Cynthia assisted with tours and enrollment. Ms. Johnson asked what our current enrollment is and what our projection was for the next school year. Ms. Bramley shared that our projection is 300 students. Ms. Johnson asked what our projected enrollment date will be. Ms. Blessum stated that by the end of this school year we hope to have 300 students. Ms. Johnson stated that she would like to see the breakdown of student enrollment to see where there might be gaps in enrollment. Ms. Johnson had very specific questions about follow up with families who had come for tours and expressed interest in Winn. Ms. Bramley shared regarding the Professional Development day (April 15) day for staff and holiday for students.

5:05 Ms. Blessum shared the changes the District has made regarding essential areas schedules for the 2022 - 2023 school year. The proposed schedule for essential areas for Winn was shared with the CAC. Ms. Blessum shared that the daily PE time is extra planning time for teachers. Ms. Khan asked why there was a problem with Prek and Kinder students going to specials at the same time. Ms. Bramley shared that we are advocating for our essential areas teachers to all be full time. She responded to questions in the chat regarding how much time students will have for art and music; what happens if an essential area teacher at another campus has seniority; our PreK students are not included in the district count for consideration regarding part/full time essential areas teachers.

5:16 Ms. Bramley asked if there were any questions or topics for discussion for the next school year; Suzie Kabat asked if we anticipate any pushback from the district regarding inclusion of PreK for essential areas. Ms. Bramley shared that, yes, the district is pushing back and Ms. Blessum is fighting for PreK inclusion. Ms. Blessum will be in meetings tomorrow regarding the essential areas scheduled for next school year. Ms. Kabat shared that Winn has done a great job of creating a schedule to accommodate all students. Ms. Stephens asked how the community can support Ms. Blessum is pushing for all students to participate in essential areas with full time teachers. A question was asked in the chat regarding keeping our current essential areas teachers in place, Navi and Ms. Sterneman. Ms. O'Neill shared that she would work on finding out who to contact. Ms. Blessum shared that her meeting was early in the morning and she would share what the outcome of the meeting is with the community. Ms. Blessum shared with the group that a lot of decisions that are stated as being made at the campus level are not actually made at the campus level. There is a meeting on Monday at noon with Ms. Alvarez. Ms. Kabat stated that the purpose of her sharing during the community comments was to let parents know what is going on and to bring them on board to advocate for Winn. Ms. Blessum shared that she does not have the autonomy to make certain decisions and she wanted to clarify that point. The district is involved, but not always aware of what is going on. She stated she would keep open communication and thanked everyone for their support for the students and staff and for attending the meeting.
